Dear Mr. Tepper:

This letter concerns the request you filed on October 7, 2021, on behalf of Base Communications, Inc. (BC), for extension of Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit AM Radio Station WSGH to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that BC stated that Station WSGH(AM) went silent on March 1, 2021, because it lost its programming source. The previous STA was granted on April 19, 2021, and expired on October 16, 2021. BC requests extension of its STA due to the COVID-19 emergency.

BC's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WSGH(AM) to remain silent until March 1, 2022. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WSGH(AM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., March 2, 2022.

BC is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If BC does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.<sup>2</sup>

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.<sup>3</sup>
