**Description:** PURPOSE OF STA REQUEST

WAY BROADCASTING LICENSEE, LLC ('WBL'), THE LICENSEE OF STATION WFBR(AM) RESPECTFULLY REQUESTS SPECIAL TEMPORARY AUTHORITY ('STA'), PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 73.1635 AND 73.68(E), TO OPERATE THIS STATION WITHOUT CERTAIN REQUIRED EQUIPMENT WHICH IS PROHIBITING THE USE OF ITS ANTENNA MONITOR. UNTIL THIS EQUIPMENT CAN BE REPLACED, ITS FIELD ENGINEER IS TAKING MONITOR POINT MEASUREMENTS TO ENSURE MAINTENANCE OF LICENSED OPERATION.

BY WAY OF BACKGROUND, DURING THE PAST SEVERAL YEARS, THIS STATION HAS BEEN PLAGUED BY COPPER-STEALING THIEVES WHO HAVE REPEATEDLY VANDALIZED THE WFBR TRANSMITTER SITE. MORE RECENTLY, THEY STOLE PORTIONS OF TWO WFBR SAMPLE LINES. AS A RESULT THE ANTENNA MONITOR CANNOT BE USED. ALTHOUGH THE STATION IS ABLE TO OPERATE AT LICENSED POWER, WBL'S FIELD ENGINEER IS TAKING MONITOR POINT MEASUREMENTS EVERY MONTH TO VERIFY THAT THE STATION IS OPERATING ACCORDING TO LICENSED PARAMETERS.

THIS SUBSTANTIAL TECHNICAL ISSUE REQUIRES THE ASSISTANCE OF WBL'S CONSULTING ENGINEER. ELECTRICAL LENGTH MEASUREMENTS MUST BE TAKEN WHICH REQUIRE THE USE OF A TIME DOMAIN REFLECTOMETER (THAT MUST BE LEASED) TO DETERMINE EXACTLY WHERE THE LINES WERE CUT AND HOW MUCH NEW LINE SHOULD BE ORDERED FOR INSTALLATION. IT SHOULD ALSO BE NOTED THAT, BECAUSE SAFETY MUST BE CONSIDERED AT THIS SITE, THE CONSULTING ENGINEER NEEDS TO BE ACCOMPANIED BY AT LEAST ONE OTHER INDIVIDUAL WHEN TAKING MEASUREMENTS, INSTALLING LINE AND/OR TESTING THE SYSTEM. FURTHER, GIVEN THAT WINTER IS UPON US, INCLEMENT WEATHER COULD DELAY COMPLETION OF REPAIRS TO THE WFBR GROUND SYSTEM.

ACCORDINGLY, WBL RESPECTFULLY REQUESTS STA, TO OPERATE WFBR WITHOUT PORTIONS OF ITS SAMPLE LINES UNTIL THEY ARE REPLACED AND THE SYSTEM IS RE-CALIBRATED.

**Exhibit 34****Description:** EXTRAORDINARY CIRCUMSTANCES WHICH WARRANT TEMPORARY OPERATIONS

WAY BROADCASTING LICENSEE, LLC ('WBL'), RESPECTFULLY REQUESTS A FURTHER EXTENSION OF THE WFBR(AM) SPECIAL TEMPORARY AUTHORIZATION ('STA'), PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 73.1635 AND 73.68(E) OF THE COMMISSION'S RULES, TO OPERATE THIS STATION WITHOUT CERTAIN REQUIRED EQUIPMENT WHICH IS PROHIBITING THE USE OF ITS ANTENNA MONITOR.

AS REPORTED PREVIOUSLY, COPPER-STEALING THIEVES REPEATEDLY VANDALIZED THE WFBR TRANSMITTER SITE AND STOLE PORTIONS OF TWO WFBR SAMPLE LINES RENDERING THE ANTENNA MONITOR UNUSABLE. WBL'S FIELD ENGINEER CONTINUES TO TAKE MONITOR POINT MEASUREMENTS TO ENSURE MAINTENANCE OF LICENSED OPERATION. DUE TO THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE TECHNICAL PROBLEM, WBL AND ITS IN-HOUSE ENGINEERS HAVE NOT BEEN ABLE TO SAFELY COMPLETE REPAIRS AND CREATE SUFFICIENT SECURITY MEASURES THAT WILL DISCOURAGE COPPER THIEVES. THIS SITUATION HAS BEEN AND CONTINUES TO BE FURTHER COMPLICATED BY THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC, WHICH HAS CAUSED WBL TO MAKE ADJUSTMENTS IN THE WAY IT CONDUCTS BUSINESS TO ENSURE THAT ITS EMPLOYEES AND CONTRACTORS REMAIN HEALTHY AND SAFE.

ACCORDINGLY, WBL RESPECTFULLY REQUESTS A FURTHER EXTENSION OF ITS STA, TO OPERATE WFBR WITHOUT PORTIONS OF ITS SAMPLE LINES UNTIL IT CAN SAFELY REPAIR THE SYSTEM AND DEFEND IT AGAINST COPPER-STEALING THIEVES.
