Description: EXTRAORDINARY CIRCUMSTANCES WARRANTING FURTHER EXTENSION OF STA

LEGACY COMMUNICATIONS LLC RESPECTFULLY REQUESTS A FURTHER EXTENSION OF THE ENGINEERING STA FOR THIS STATION.

THIS EXTENSION IS NECESSARY TO DUE TO DELAYS IN COMPLETING TESTING PRIOR TO RETURNING THE NIGHTTIME ANTENNA SYSTEM TO DIRECTIONAL MODE. THE COMMISSION PREVIOUSLY GRANTED AN EXTENSION OF THIS STA ON JULY 22, 2021 (FILE NO.: BESTA-20210706AAM).

SINCE THE MOST RECENT EXTENSION WAS GRANTED, LEGACY'S CONSULTING ENGINEER HAS TRAGICALLY PASSED AWAY FROM COVID-19 CAUSES. SPECIALIZED IMPEDANCE TUNING TEST EQUIPMENT IS NECESSARY TO RETURN THE STATION'S NIGHTTIME BROADCASTS TO DIRECTIONAL OPERATION. PREVIOUSLY, LEGACY'S LOCAL ENGINEER ATTEMPTED TO TUNE THE STATION'S PHASERS HIMSELF, BUT WAS UNSUCCESSFUL WITHOUT THE NECESSARY SPECIALIZED ELECTRICAL IMPEDANCE MEASUREMENT EQUIPMENT. LEGACY IS SEEKING TO ENGAGE A NEW CONSULTING ENGINEER WHO POSSESSES SUCH EQUIPMENT TO PERFORM THE NECESSARY WORK.

THE STATION CONTINUES TO OPERATE AT 250 WATTS NON-DIRECTIONAL AT NIGHT UNTIL THE ENGINEERING TESTING WORK CAN BE COMPLETED AND IT IS RESTORED TO OPERATION AT ITS FULL LICENSED PARAMETERS. A GRANT OF THIS REQUEST FOR FURTHER EXTENSION OF THE STA WILL SERVE THE PUBLIC INTEREST BY ALLOWING KRGI TO OPERATE DURING NIGHTTIME HOURS. KRGI SERVES GRAND ISLAND, NEBRASKA, WITH A NEWS/TALK FORMAT. THE PROGRAMMING ON THIS STATION IS VITAL TO THE RESIDENTS OF HALL COUNTY AND THE SURROUNDING AREAS.

FOR THESE REASONS, LEGACY COMMUNICATIONS LLC RESPECTFULLY REQUESTS A FURTHER EXTENSION OF THE ENGINEERING STA FOR KRGI(AM)'S NIGHTTIME OPERATION.
