Dear Mr. Loughery:

This is in reference to the request filed on January 5, 2022. Four Rivers requests a final extension of the STA granted on January 19, 2021, to continue ND operation to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application to cover BP-20210707AAB. In support of the request, Four Rivers stated that it plans to file the application within the next several months.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and Four Rivers may continue to operate ND with 0.124 kW day and 0.022 kW night. Four Rivers must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310.

This authority expires on July 26, 2022.
