Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed March 10, 2008, on behalf of Radio Representatives, Inc. (RRI), for further extension of the special temporary authority (STA) originally granted on October 14, 1997, and modified on March 24, 2004, for operation of Station KGDP with 2.5 kilowatts daytime and 250 watts nighttime, employing an existing nondirectional antenna.

Our review indicates that, subsequent to the filing of the extension request, RRI completed construction of modified KGDP facilities authorized by Construction Permit BMP-20060915AFJ, and that License BL-20080505AER, to cover the permit, was granted on July 30, 2008. Thus, the requested STA is no longer necessary.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY DISMISSED.
