Mt. Rushmore Broadcasting, Inc. (“Licensee”) licensee of KMLD (FM), 94.5 MHz, Casper, Wyoming (Facility ID No. 11927) (the “Station”), by its undersigned attorneys, hereby requests an extension of its existing Engineering Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to continue operating with temporary facilities, which the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) most recently extended by BESTA-20210730AAH.

Licensee was granted a construction permit on August 6, 2019, pursuant to File No. BP-20190530AAP. However, Licensee requires additional time to construct new permanent facilities. COVID-19 precautions have led to a backlog of equipment deliveries and a reduction in workforce to maintain the Station’s facilities, which continue to hamper its progress.

Licensee hereby certifies that neither it nor any party to this application is subject to denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 862. Licensee also hereby certifies that the statements here are true, complete, and correct to the best of its knowledge and belief, and are made in good faith.
