On behalf of Educational Media Foundation (“EMF”) (FRN 0004121000), licensee of the above-referenced station, pursuant to the Audio Division guidance issued on January 11, 2022, and January 25, 2022, we respectfully request special temporary authority for the station to remain silent.

The station went off the air on January 27, 2022, and EMF is not certain of the cause. Unfortunately, the current weather conditions make the site inaccessible. As soon as possible, EMF will access the site and make the required repairs to return the station to operations. EMF respectfully requests special temporary authority to remain silent. EMF will promptly notify the Commission when the station resumes licensed operations.
