Dear Mr. Lopez:

This is in reference to the request filed on February 2, 2022. ABC requests a further extension of the STA granted on September 29, 2017, to continue ND operation to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters.¹ In support of the request, ABC also stated that an FCC Form 301 application to make permanent changes to the co-located WRSJ facility is being filed soon, therefore additional technical changes to the WQBS facility may also be required before it can restore licensed operations.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:


- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for an extension of the STA is **HEREBY GRANTED**, and ABC may continue ND operation (day and night) using a maximum of 1.25 kW. ABC must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310.

This authority expires on **August 10, 2022**.

¹ WQBS(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 870 kHz with 5 kW (day and night) using the same pattern.
