Dear Mr. Dowdy:

This is in reference to the request filed on February 7, 2022. FMI requests a further extension of the STA granted on July 14, 2022, to continue daytime-only operation due to damage to the nighttime DA antenna system.¹ In support of the request, we noted that FMI did not repair the nighttime antenna system over the past seven months or file an FCC Form 301 application to make permanent changes.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and FMI may continue to operate with the licensed daytime 5 kW antenna system, with no nighttime operation. FMI must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR 1.1310. FMI must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date an FCC Form 301 application was filed to propose a permanent daytime only facility (as previously proposed in BP-20171204ABW), or to make other changes. Otherwise FMI must repair the nighttime DA

antenna system and file an FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters.

This authority expires on **August 21, 2022**.
