Dear Ms. Dortch:

This request is filed on behalf of Salem Communications Holding Corporation, licensee of WTLN(AM), Orlando, FL, facility ID 23442. WTLN is currently operating in non-directional mode at 25% of licensed power per BSTA-20210811AAD, due to fire damage at one of the station's broadcast towers. Work on this project continues with significant progress. The majority of the custom fabricated replacement parts have been delivered recently (2/4/2022) and being checked prior to install. Further cleanup will be necessary before installation. Considering the additional time required for the remaining cleaning and prep, installation of replacement components, tuning and testing with only a limited amount of time for off air work, we respectfully request an additional 180 day extension of the STA to allow WTLN to continue uninterrupted operation with one of the daytime towers configured for non-directional operation at 25% of the station's licensed power (12.5kw day / 3.5kw night).

The licensee has authorized undersigned counsel to certify on its behalf that the licensee is not subject to denial of Federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 862.
