Application for Extension of Special Temporary Authorization for WEGA-AM

A Radio Company, Inc., respectfully requests an extension of STA to operate WEGA with an emergency antenna as previously authorized, file number: BESTA-20210830AAH, pending construction of facilities as authorized in BP-20210330AAD.


The commission previously authorized WEGA to operate with parameters at variance using a non-directional antenna at a power of 0.625kW as authorized, most recently extended by BSTA-20210830AAH.

The licensee is working with the consulting engineering firm Hatfield & Dawson on completing the necessary measurements for that firm to prepare the technical documents in support of the application for a license as per the facilities authorized in BP-20211033AAD. That engineering firm requested recently calibrated instruments for the tower's measurements. The WEGA licensee sent a field intensity meter for calibration. An impedance bridge and WEGA antenna phase monitor are also being sent for calibration.

Lastly, an inspection by the undersigned to the installed antenna sampling system determined that the sampling lines are of different lengths and therefore do not qualify for the Method of Moment certification. Thus, the licensee is ordering a new set of phase-matched sampling lines.

WEGA licensee will conduct the necessary tower measurements upon receiving the calibrated equipment and the new set of sampling lines installed. The remaining construction is complete.

Grant of this request would serve the public interest, as it would allow WEGA to continue serving listeners in the community of Vega Baja and the surrounding areas. Therefore, an extension of authority for 180 days is respectfully requested.
