Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Fat Dawgs 7 Broadcasting, LLC, the licensee of the above referenced station (“KFPT” or the “Station”), this is to notify the Commission that on February 23, 2022, it was discovered that multiple component failures inside the Station’s transmitter made operation at the licensed 5 kW daytime nominal power difficult, so that the Station is now operating at 3 kW daytime nominal power. No other operational changes from the Station’s license (File BML-20060821AEE) are involved.


As the transmitter manufacturer (Harris) has stated that parts are currently unavailable due to the age of the equipment and sourcing issues caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, it is uncertain when equipment repairs can be made to return the Station to licensed power. Consequently, Special Temporary Authority to operate KFPT with its licensed antenna system with reduced power is hereby requested.

The licensee reports that this operation is excluded from environmental processing under 47. C.F.R. Section 1.1306 (*i.e.*, the facility does not have a significant environmental impact and complies with the maximum permissible radiofrequency electromagnetic exposure limits for controlled and uncontrolled environments).
