On behalf of Midwest Communications, Inc., licensee of the above-referenced station, you are respectfully requested to grant special temporary authority for station WTHI-FM to operate from its licensed tower site as follows:

Tower Site: ASRN 1029950
RCAGL: 162 M
ERP: 41.6 kW
STA Diplex with WMGI (FAC 6828)

WMGI's tower structure was damaged during a tree clearing project and was issued STA (BSTA-20211210AAG) to operate from the WTHI-FM tower structure (ASRN 1029950) until such time as the licensed tower may be rebuilt.

To facilitate WMGI and WTHI-FM operation, ERI was commissioned to develop and install a combined facility for WMGI at the existing WTHI-FM tower site using the existing WTHI-FM antenna as described on the Technical Report submitted with this STA request.

WMGI has filed a contemporaneous request to modify its STA (BSTA-20211210AAG) so as to diplex with WTHI-FM.

STA is in the public interest so that the station may continue to broadcast important information to its listening audience until repairs may be completed.

Applicant certifies that neither applicant nor any party to the application is subject to denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. Section 862.
