Dear Mr. Luciano:

This is in reference to the request filed on March 8, 2022. ARC requests a further extension of the STA granted on October 29, 2004, to continue ND operation to allow time to complete the nighttime method of moment proof and file the required FCC Form 302 application.¹ In support of the request, ARC stated that additional time will be needed to complete the proof and file the application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and ARC may continue to operate ND using one of the licensed towers with a maximum of 0.625 kW (day and

night). ARC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310.

This authority expires on September 22, 2022.
