On behalf of our client, Silver State Broadcasting, LLC ("Silver State"), debtor in possession under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code by authority of Judge August Landis of the Bankruptcy Court for the District of Nevada, this is to report that FM radio broadcast station KFRH, North Las Vegas, Nevada (FCC facility ID 19062) suspended operations on February 22, 2022. This is according to information provided to the undersigned by counsel for VCY America, Inc., which had operated the station previously under a local programming and marketing agreement with a court-appointed receiver for KFRH.

I am informed that efforts are under way to return KFRH to the air soon, but that these efforts have been complicated by the impending loss of the station's studio space and by damage to and/or loss of certain items of studio equipment during the pendency of the receivership. In the meantime, we hereby request special temporary authority for the station to remain silent until further notice.

This will also serve to certify that the licensee and station KFRH are in compliance with the provisions of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.
