On behalf of our client, Golden State Broadcasting, LLC ("Golden State"), debtor in possession under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code by authority of Judge August Landis of the Bankruptcy Court for the District of Nevada, this is to report that FM radio broadcast station KREV, Alameda, California (FCC facility ID 36029) suspended operations on February 22, 2022. This is according to information provided to the undersigned by counsel for VCY America, Inc., which had operated the station previously under a local programming and marketing agreement with a court-appointed receiver for KREV.

I am informed that efforts are under way to return KREV to the air as soon as possible, but that it will likely take at least two weeks for that work to be accomplished. In the meantime, we hereby request special temporary authority for the station to remain silent until further notice.

This will also serve to certify that Golden State and station KREV are in compliance with the provisions of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.
