Audio Division of the Federal Communications Commission:

This email shall serve as notification to the Commission that non-commercial educational radio station WICR-FM 88.7 in Indianapolis is operating at reduced power due to a main transmitter failure in March. Attempts to repair the transmitter have been unsuccessful, largely due to the age of the equipment. The manufacturer says the needed parts are no longer available.

Therefore, we are requesting a Special Temporary Authorization to allow us to continue operating at reduced power while we purchase and install a new transmitter. Even at a lower power, we are continuing to serve our city of license and still reach the majority of our coverage area.

Please acknowledge the receipt of this notification and advise as to whether additional action is needed in order to be considered for an STA.
