Dear Ms. Guel:

This is in reference to the request filed on April 4, 2022. HFCN requests an extension of the STA granted on September 9, 2021, to continue operating ND with reduced power to allow time to replace one damaged tower and a phasor, and then file the required FCC Form 302 application.¹ In support of the request, HFCN stated that the damaged tower has not been replaced yet, and therefore additional time will be needed to complete all remaining repairs (before filing the application to update all operating parameters).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and HFCN may continue to operate ND with 0.125 kW day and night. HFCN must reduce power or cease operations if complaints of interference are received, and must use whatever means are necessary

to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310. HFCN must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date the application was filed (due to the tower replacement) to allow our staff to determine if any further STA operation will be required.

This authority expires on **October 7, 2022**.
