On behalf of IHM LICENSES, LLC, licensee of WWRL(AM) Facility ID 68906 New York, NY, (the "Station"), this letter is to request Special Temporary Authority ("STA") for emergency antenna operation.

The antenna pattern switching control system has suffered a failure and requires extensive repairs caused by a burst water pipe that also damaged some phasing and power dividing components as well; making normal operations impossible.

We are requesting STA for non-directional operation using tower 2, ASR 1051682, at 25% of licensed power for day and night as appropriate while repairs are made. The interests of the public will be served by the station continuing to serve the community as repairs are made.

Also note that the station is has recently filed BMML-20211119AAH and is operating via separate STA, BSTA-20211021AAB, while awaiting grant of that application. An extension request for that STA has been filed as BESTA-20220414AAB.
