Dear Mr. Langham:

This is in reference to the request filed on April 18, 2022. IHM requests an extension of the STA originally granted on November 19, 2020, as modified to continue operating ND with 25% power due to recent water damage to the multiple antenna system components.¹ In support of the request, IHM stated that additional time will be needed to complete extensive repairs before it can restore licensed operations.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and IHM may continue to operate ND using tower #2 (ASRN # 1051682) with a maximum of 6.25 kW day, and 1.25 kW night. IHM must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310. IHM must submit a brief e-mail to my attention to note the date the station was able to resume operations using the parameters given in BMML-20211119AAH
