Dear Mr. Pham:

This is in reference to the request filed on March 24, 2022. PRC requests an extension of the STA granted on September 29, 2020, to continue operating ND with reduced power to allow time to complete all required repairs after resolving recurring vandalism problems.¹ In support of the request, PRC stated that additional time will be needed to work with the site owner to come up with a solution.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and PRC may continue to operate ND with a maximum of 0.25 kW day and 0.625 kW night. PRC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. PRC must submit a brief e-mail to my attention to note the date the station was able to resumed licensed operations per BMML-20110620AIE with negligible changes.

¹ KVVN(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1430 kHz with 1 kW day and 2.5 kW night, using different patterns.
