Dear Mr. Price:

This letter concerns the request you filed on February 28, 2022, on behalf of My Bridge Radio (MBR), for extension of Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit FM Translator Station K257GW to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that MBR stated that Station K257GW went silent on August 31, 2021, for technical reasons. The previous STA was granted on December 29, 2021, and will expire on June 27, 2022. MBR requests extension of its STA for continuing technical reasons.

MBR's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station K257GW to remain silent until August 31, 2022. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station K257GW will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., September 1, 2022.

MBR is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If MBR does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.<sup>2</sup>

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.<sup>3</sup>
