Dear Former Permittee:

This is with respect to the above captioned expired construction permit. Commission records indicate that you failed to file an application for license to cover by the construction permit expiration date.<sup>1</sup> Section 74.788(b) of the Commission's rules states that:

Any construction permit for which construction has not been completed and for which an application for license or extension of time has not been filed, shall be automatically forfeited upon expiration without any further affirmative cancellation by the Commission.<sup>2</sup>

As such, the construction permit was automatically forfeited.

Accordingly, pursuant to sections 74.788(b) of the Commission's rules, the construction permit for the station referenced above was **AUTOMATICALLY FORFEITED** and the call sign

In that decision, the Commission extended the expiration date of valid construction permits for new digital low power television stations to the LPTV digital transition date which is set as 12 months following the completion of the 39-month post-Incentive Auction transition period or 51 months from the completion of the Incentive Auction and the release of the *Closing and Channel Reassignment Public Notice*. *Id.* See *Incentive Auction Closing and Channel Reassignment Public Notice: The Broadcast Television Incentive Auction Closes; Reverse Auction and Forward Auction Results Announced; Final Television Band Channel Assignments Announced; Post-Auction Deadlines Announced*, Public Notice, 32 FCC Rcd 2786 (IATF and MB 2018). Given the April 13, 2017 release date of the *Closing and Channel Reassignment Public Notice*, the LPTV digital transition date and expiration date of all valid construction permits for new digital LPTV stations were set as July 13, 2021.

has been **DELETED**.<sup>3</sup> All authority to construct the stations have been **TERMINATED**. All pending applications will also be **DISMISSED**.
