REQUEST FOR SPECIAL TEMPORARY AUTHORITY

Station KDDD-FM Dumas, TX FACID 74311

With this letter, Highway 64 Radio, LLC requests Special Temporary Authority (STA) to operate at reduced power on a backup antenna for the noted FM station.

On May 2, station personnel were notified by the Moore County Airport Authority that spurious emissions may be emanating from the KDDD-FM antenna, causing interference to aviation approach frequencies. On May 3, a coordinated flight test was made while station personnel were at the KDDD-FM tower. While the suspected interference was being monitored, the KDDD-FM transmitter was turned off, confirming it as the source of the emissions.

The KDDD-FM main transmitter and antenna have been removed from service and a stand-by transmitter into a 1-bay emergency antenna on the tower has been placed into operation, on the authorized tower location and operating frequency. The attached map shows the operating 70dBu (50,50) contour encompasses the city of license.

The applicant certifies that all parties to the application are in compliance with Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. Section 862, the federal law which provides federal and state court judges the discretion to deny federal benefits to individuals convicted of offenses consisting of the distribution of controlled substances.
