Dear Mr. Moskowitz:

This letter concerns the request you filed on March 4, 2022, on behalf of New Radio System, Inc. (NRS), for Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit AM Radio Station KXPL to remain silent.

NRS's request states that Station KXPL(AM) went silent on February 28, 2022, for technical reasons.

NRS's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station KXPL(AM) to remain silent not to exceed 180 days from the date of this letter. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station KXPL(AM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., March 1, 2023.¹

NRS is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If NRS does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.²

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.³
