On the behalf of Tyler Media, LLC, ("Tyler"), the Licensee of KOKC (AM), Oklahoma City, Oklahoma (FAC# 73981) ("Station" or "KOKC"), this is to respectfully request an Extension Special Temporary Authority ("STA") granted in BESTA-202111103AAC (STA Letter Attached). Dear Mr. Tyler:

This is in reference to the request filed on November 3, 2021. TM requests a further extension of the STA granted on January 17, 2012, to continue operating using the shorter tower constructed in 2015 (due to destruction of the original antenna system) to allow time to file the required FCC Form 301 application to propose a new permanent facility. In support of the request, TM stated that it plans to move forward with the project in the upcoming months.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.
