On behalf of IHM LICENSES, LLC, licensee of KXYZ (AM) Facility ID 95, Houston, TX (the "Station"), this letter is to request Special Temporary Authority ("STA") to continue service with parameters at variance from licensed values.

The station antenna is being relocated to the facility of co-owned KMBE via construction permit BP-202010125AAC, additionally co-owned station KPRC is being relocated via construction permit BP-20200917AAN to the same facility where the stations will operate in a tri-plex arrangement.

As we complete construction of the above specified permitted facilities, we seek STA to operate KXYZ non-directionally from tower 7 or 8 of the array with permitted day mode power, and up to 25% of night mode directional permitted power.

Additionally, we request STA following completion of construction to operate the facility as permitted with substantially adjusted parameter as we prepare to file an application for license to cover. The complexity of 3 directional stations sharing a set of tower elements greatly complicates the preparation of documentation required for complete filing of the application.

The interests of the public will be served by the station continuing to operate as these improvements are made to the facility. Please direct any inquiries regarding this matter to the undersigned.
