Facility ID No. 197418 Silent since September 17, 2021 Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Krueger:

This letter concerns the request you filed on March 14, 2022, on behalf of Calvary Broadcasting, Inc. (CB), for extension of Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit Low Power FM Station WCGF-LP to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that CB stated that Station WCGF-LP went silent on September 17, 2021, for technical reasons. The previous STA was granted on December 16, 2021, and will expire on June 14, 2022. CB requests extension of its STA for continuing technical reasons.

CB's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WCGF-LP to remain silent until September 17, 2022. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WCGF-LP will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., September 18, 2022.

CB is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If CB does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.²

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.³
