



Reduced Power Operation Special Temporary Authority

NCE Station KWSU(AM), Pullman, Washington (Facility ID 71025)

Pursuant to Sections 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the FCC's Rules, Washington State University ("WSU"), licensee of noncommercial educational radio Station KWSU(AM), Pullman, Washington, respectfully requests Special Temporary Authority ("STA") to maintain the reduced power status of KWSU(AM) for more than thirty (30) days.

Station KWSU(AM) has been operating at approximately 1.23% of authorized power levels (61.72 watts) since May 10, 2022 due to transmitter equipment problems. On May 23, 2022, WSU notified the Commission of KWSU(AM)'s reduced power operation. *See* LMS File Number 0000191336. The station is presently working on obtaining replacement parts as needed to restore full power operation but expects that the purchase and installation process will take more than thirty (30) days. A grant of reduced power STA will serve the public interest by allowing the licensee to maintain, without interruption, the station's current noncommercial educational radio operation for its local community pending completion of the equipment replacement.

WSU is a public institution of higher education and a governmental entity. *See* REV. CODE WASH. § 28B.10.016. Furthermore, WSU operates KWSU(AM) on a noncommercial educational basis. The licensee and station are therefore exempt from FCC fee requirements pursuant to Sections 1.1116 and 1.1162 of the Commission's Rules.
