Dear Mr. Cruz:

This is in reference to the request filed on June 6, 2022. PBS requests a further extension of the STA granted on September 20, 2019, to continue operating with DA parameters at variance to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application.¹ In support of the request, PBS stated that it has resumed full power operation with DA parameters at variance, and plans to file the application in the upcoming months to update all engineering parameters.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and PBS may continue to operate day and night with DA parameters at variance (and reduced power if needed) while maintaining all monitor points within licensed limits. PBS must use whatever

means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. PBS must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date the application was filed with the audiofilings team.

This authority expires on **December 9, 2022.**
