> RE: WTOF(AM), Bay Minette, AL Facility ID No. 24653 Silent since December 5, 2021 Request for Special Temporary Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Trent:

This letter concerns the request you filed on December 8, 2021, on behalf of Buddy Tucker Association, Inc. (BTA), for Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit AM Radio Station WTOF to remain silent.

BTA's request states that Station WTOF(AM) went silent on December 5, 2021, for technical reasons.

BTA's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WTOF(AM) to remain silent until December 5, 2022. Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WTOF(AM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., December 6, 2022.¹

BTA is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If BTA does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.²

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.³
