ENGINEERING STATEMENT OF CARL T. JONES, JR., P.E. IN SUPPORT OF A REQUEST FOR SPECIAL TEMPORARY AUTHORITY KRDC(AM) – PASADENA, CALIFORNIA 1110 kHz – 50.0 kW DAY, 20.0 kW NIGHT, DA-2, U FACILITY ID: 25076

LICENSEE: ABC RADIO LOS ANGELES ASSETS, LLC

I am a Consulting Engineer and president of Carl T. Jones Corporation, with offices located in Springfield, Virginia. My education and experience are a matter of record with the Federal Communications Commission. I am a Registered Professional Engineer in the Commonwealth of Virginia, Registration No. 013391.

This office has been authorized by ABC Radio Los Angeles Assets, LLC ("ABC Radio LA"), licensee of AM Station KRDC, Pasadena, California, to prepare this engineering statement in support of a Request for Special Temporary Authority. KRDC is licensed to operate on 1110 kHz with a daytime power of 50.0 kW and a nighttime power of 20 kW. The station uses different directional patterns for its daytime and nighttime operations (DA-2).

Good Karma Broadcasting, L.L.C. ("Good Karma"), the licensee of AM Station KSPN, Los Angeles, Californina, has been granted a construction permit to relocate the KSPN transmission facilities to the KRDC transmitter site and diplex on the KRDC towers.<sup>1</sup> Good Karma is preparing to implement the KSPN construction permit which will require equipment to be installed and adjusted at the base of all five of the KRDC towers.

In order to facilitate the implementation of the KSPN Construction Permit and to

protect workers during the installation and adjustment of the required diplexing

equipment, it will be necessary to operate KRDC non-directionally or at reduced power.

Further, it is expected that the installation of the diplexing filters will result in KRDC

operating at variance with its license parameters until such time that all constrtuction

and adjustments are completed and the KRDC directional operations can be restored to

a licensed condition. Therefore, special temporary authority is requested to operate

KRDC: 1) nondirectionally during daytime and nighttime hours at a power no greater

than 25% of the authorized power; 2) directionally during daytime and nighttime hours

with parameters at variance; and 3) directionally at reduced power during daytime and

nighttime hours, as necessary.

Once the KSPN transmission facilities are constructed and adjusted in

compliance with the terms of the construction permit and the KRDC directional patterns

have been restored to a licensed condition, an Application to Return to Direct

Measuremnent of Power (FCC Form 302) will be filed requesting new daytime and

nighttime operating parameters.
