

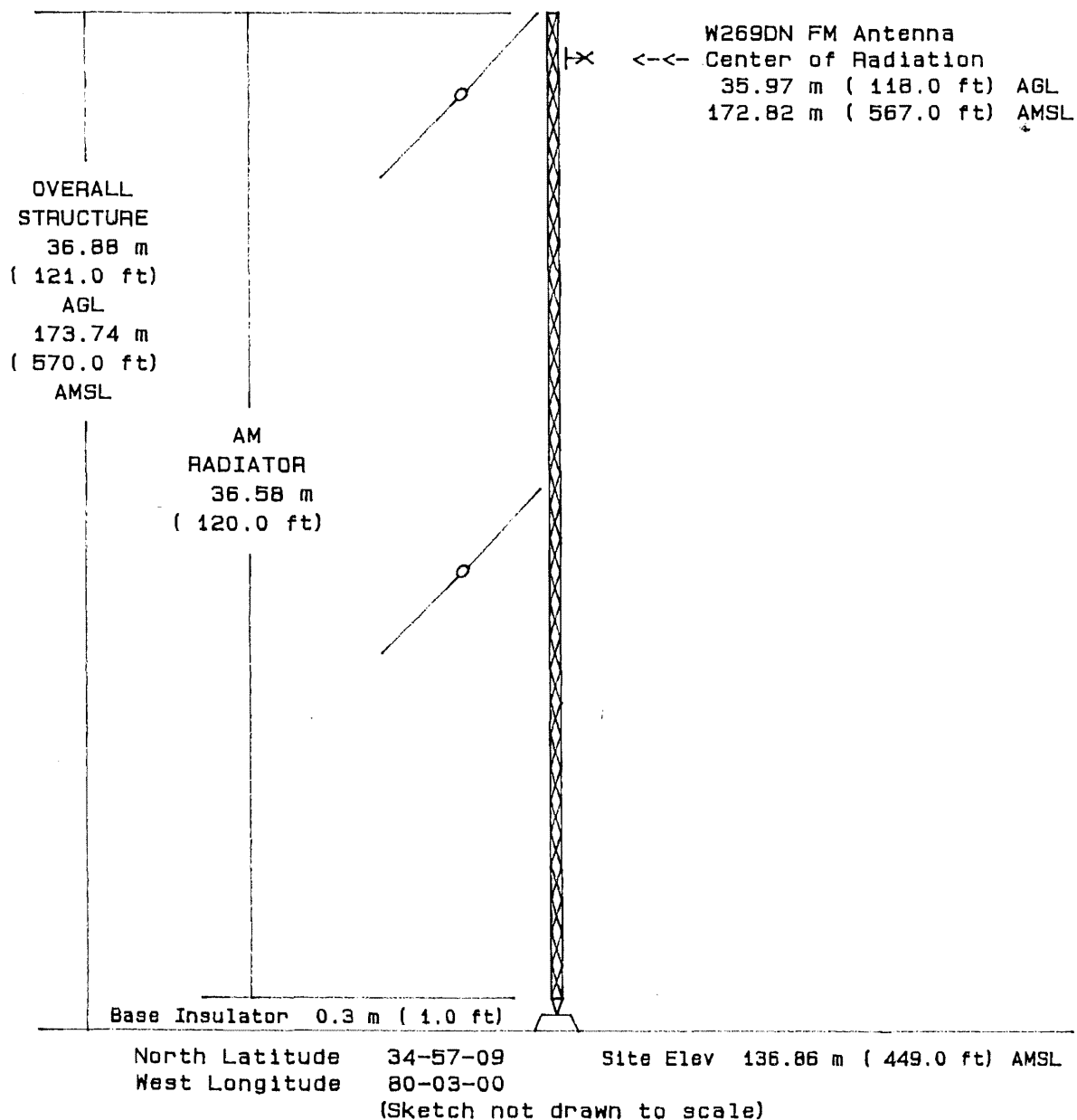

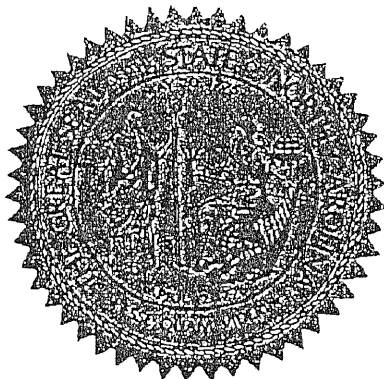

The undersigned, being of the age of eighteen (18) years or more, does hereby make and acknowledge these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of North Carolina.

1. The name of the corporation is NEW LIFE COMMUNITY TEMPLE OF FAITH, INC.

2. The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

3. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are as follows:

(a) to establish and maintain a place for the worship of Almighty God, to provide for Christian fellowship for those of like precious faith and to assume a share of responsibility for and the privilege of propagating the gospel of Jesus Christ by all available means, both at home and in foreign lands;

(b) to secure for all its members a more liberal and systematic ministry to meet the spiritual, Christian, educational, and psychological needs of all members of the church;

(c) to provide opportunities for the members to use their talents and gifts so as to develop themselves as mature and dedicated Christians;

(d) to contribute to the Christian cause of missions throughout the world; and

(e) to engage in any other lawful activities consistent with the purposes of non-profit religious corporations and not otherwise prohibited to like non-profit corporations.

4. The corporation shall have members which may be divided into such classes as shall be provided by the by-laws. All members shall be accepted, appointed, elected, or designated in the manner provided in the by-laws.

5. The directors of the corporation shall be elected or appointed in the manner and for the terms provided in the by-laws.

6. Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) on the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501(3)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Superior Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes

or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
