Dear Mr. Dawson:

This is in reference to the request filed on June 30, 2022. CCR requests an extension of the STA granted on January 14, 2022, to continue operating with a reduced daytime power to allow time to repair substantial damage caused by Hurricane Ida in September 2021 and file the required FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters.¹ In support of the request, CCR stated that it has retained the engineering firm Technical Services Group to complete all remaining repairs in order to restore licensed operations.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of STA is GRANTED, and CCR may continue to operate DA daytime with a reduced power of 1.3 kW with no change to the licensed nighttime

¹ WPYR(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1380 kHz with 5 kW day, using the same augmented pattern at night with a reduced power of 0.062 kW.

operation. CCR must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. CCR must submit the FCC Form 302 application via e-mail to the audiofilings team after all repairs have been completed (if any changes are necessary). Otherwise an e-mail must be submitted to my attention to note the date the station resumed licensed operations per BML-20210201ASD with negligible changes to all engineering parameters.

This authority expires on **January 12, 2023**.
