Dear Mr. Napoleon:

This is in reference to the request filed on July 12, 2022. WL requests a further extension of the STA originally granted on August 31, 2018, and last modified on October 13, 2021 to allow operation from an alternate site to allow time to file the required FCC Form 301 application for a new permanent facility (due to destruction of the licensed tower in 2017, and the loss of the licensed site in 2021).¹ In support of the request, we noted that WJBW will need to resume STA operations before 7/21/22 and file an electronic resumption notice in LMS on the same date to avoid cancellation of the station's license.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, this supersedes the authorization granted on July 15, 2022, and the modified request for extension of the STA is hereby GRANTED, and WL may continue operating with the following facilities:

WL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310. We recommend that WL file the FCC Form 301 application as soon as possible to avoid further problems.

This authority expires on **January 14, 2023**.
