WFBR(AM) Request to Extend Special Temporary Authorization

Way Broadcasting Licensee, LLC (“Way”), licensee of Station WFBR(AM), Glen Burnie, Maryland (Fac. ID 19673), respectfully requests an extension of its Special Temporary Authorization (“STA”), pursuant to Sections 73.1635 and 73.68(e) of the Commission’s rules, to operate this Station without certain required equipment which is prohibiting the use of its antenna monitor.

The Commission has been made aware that the WFBR transmitter site has been repeatedly vandalized. Thieves stole portions of two WFBR sample lines rendering the antenna monitor unuseable. Way’s field engineer continues to take monitor point measurements to ensure licensed operation is maintained.

Since the submission of its last Extension Request, Way has hired a new consulting engineer to determine what can be done so that this Station can resume licensed operations. In addition Way has replaced its Chief Financial Officer (“CFO”), who is now handling this project. The new CFO, with the assistance of the new consulting engineer, will determine what equipment needs to be repaired or replaced to eliminate this STA.

In the meantime, Way respectfully requests a futher extension of its STA to operate without portions of its sample lines until the WFBR system can be repaired. This will allow the Station to continue to provide service to its listeners in the Glen Burnie area.
