Dear Mr. Do:

This is in reference to the request filed on July 27, 2022. Intelli requests a further extension of the STA granted on April 20, 2021, to continue operating from an alternate site with a temporary roof top antenna to allow time to file the required FCC Form 301 application, due to loss of the licensed site in 2020. In support of the request, we noted that Intelli did not file the application over the past year.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond
 the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve
 the problem.

The previous STA expired on June 28, 2022, therefore the authority granted herein does not cover the period between that date and the filing date of this request, and is without prejudice as to whatever action the Commission may take with respect to operation of the station during the foregoing period.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is hereby GRANTED, and Intelli may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Electrical height of radiator 7 electrical degrees
