Dear Ms. Dortch:

Audacy License, LLC ("Audacy"), licensee of WEEI(AM), Boston, MA (Facility ID No. 1912) (the "Station"), hereby requests special temporary authority ("STA") to operate both the daytime and nighttime directional antenna systems with operating parameters at variance.

Station personnel recently noticed a change in licensed parameters going out of tolerance. The change coincided with work being performed by a tenant on an adjacent cellular tower. Work on that adjacent tower is excepted to continue for some time. Therefore, final detuning of the tower will not be completed until all of the work is finished. As a result, Licensee requests authority to operate the Station with parameters at variance for a period of 180 days.

Upon receipt of the filing number for this request, Audacy will pay the necessary filing fee.

Audacy, through its undersigned counsel, hereby certifies that neither Audacy nor any party holding an attributable interest in Audacy is subject to denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. Section 862.
