We are requesting an extension of the STA (File Number BSTA-20220218AAF) to operate WECU – 1570 AM at a reduced daytime power of 1000 watts from its existing transmitter site in Winterville, NC. It is scheduled to expire August 21, 2022. We are making progress attempting to repair our 10000 watt LPB transmitter but will most likely not be finished until the end of 2022. We have finally repaired and installed a reliable 1000 watt LPB backup transmitter to operate WECU at a reduced daytime power of 1000 watts. We continue to operate at our nighttime licensed power of 200 watts. Unfortunately, LPB (and Omnitronix which preceded it) as a company no longer exists and there are very few people who have the knowledge and ability to repair these transmitters. Fortunately, we have identified competent AM engineering help, along with sufficient stock of LPB parts and surplus components from other used LPB transmitters and we hope to be able to bring the main transmitter online to reach WECU's full licensed daytime power.
