Dear Madam Secretary:

On behalf of John Ostlund and Katrina Ostlund, licensee of the above-referenced station, you are respectfully requested to issue special temporary authority for station KYNO to operate nondirectional at 25% of licensed power using licensed tower #2 while maintaining monitor points due to ground system vandalism including copper theft.

KYNO is licensed at 50kW DA-2 day and night.

The KYNO ground system has been vandalized by copper thieves preventing the station from operating at full licensed parameters. The station is working with insurance claims and service providers in the process of developing a plan to repair the tower ground field. Until repairs may be completed, KYNO seeks STA to operate nondirectional at 25% of licensed power using licensed tower #2 (ASRN 1013935) while maintaining monitor points.

STA is in the public interest so that the station may continue to broadcast important information to its listening audience until repairs may be completed.

Applicant certifies that neither applicant nor any party to the application is subject to denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. Section 862.
