Audio Division Staff:

International Broadcasting Corporation (“Licensee”) licensee of WRSJ(AM), 1520 kHz, San Juan, PR (Facility ID No. 54958) (the “Station”), by its undersigned attorneys, hereby requests an extension of its existing Engineering Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to operate the Station at 1 KW NDA, which the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) most recently extended by File No. BESTA-20220131AAG.

The Station was initially silent as a result of equipment damage caused by Hurricane Maria and has since returned to the air. On February 18, 2022, the Station submitted an application for Minor Change to a Licensed Facility (“Minor Modification”), File No. BP-20220218AAN. On August 6, 2022, the Station filed an amendment in response to the Audio Division’s request for additional information. Licensee hereby respectfully requests an extension of its existing STA while the FCC considers its Minor Modification application.

Licensee hereby certifies that neither it nor any party to this application is subject to denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 862. Licensee also hereby certifies that the statements here are true, complete, and correct to the best of its knowledge and belief, and are made in good faith.
