WLZR(AM) Request for Special Temporary Authorization

Cumulus Licensing LLC ('Cumulus') respectfully requests a Special Temporary Authorization ("STA") to allow Station WLZR(AM), Melbourne, Florida, to operate with a temporary, wire antenna, pursuant to Sections 73.1635 and 73.1680 of the Rules.

Station WLZR is licensed to operate on 1560 kHz during daytime hours in the non-directional mode with 5 kiloWatts of power. A severe storm during the morning of August 8, 2022, caused the WLZR tower to collapse. In order to get the Station back on the air, Cumulus engineers erected a temporary, wire antenna. As a result, WLZR is currently operating with 100 Watts of power. Cumulus and the tower owner, Vertical Bridge, are in the process of discussing a permanent solution to this catastrophic event as well as alternative options to allow for the Station to increase its power.

In the meantime, Cumulus respectfully requests a STA to allow WLZR to remain on the air with 100 Watts of power utilizing a wire antenna until further technical plans are solidified. Positive action on this Request will enable the Station to continue to serve the residents of Melbourne while Cumulus and Vertical Bridge develop alternative and permanent plans to resolve this major technical setback.
