Dear Mr. Lopez:

This is in reference to the request filed on August 10, 2022. IBC requests a further extension of the STA granted on February 27, 2019, to continue ND operation to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application to cover BP-20220218AAN (due to the loss of one tower in 2019).¹ In support of the request, we noted that BP-20220218AAN remains under review by our staff at this time (based upon a recently filed amendment).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:


- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is **HEREBY GRANTED**, and IBC may continue ND operation (day and night) using a maximum of 1 kW. IBC must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310.

¹ WRSJ(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1520 kHz with 25 kW (day and night) using the same pattern, and BP-20220218AAN proposes a new 10 kW unlimited array using the two remaining towers.

This authority expires on **February 17, 2023**.
