Dear Mr. Langham:

This is in reference to the request filed on August 18, 2022. IHM requests a further extension of the STA granted on January 15, 2020, to continue operating ND at night with reduced power to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application to verify all operating parameters.¹ In support of the request, IHM stated that additional time is needed to complete final adjustments to the nighttime antenna system.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and IHM may continue to operate ND at night using tower #1 with a maximum power level of 12.5 kW, with no change to the licensed daytime 50 kW ND operation. IHM must reduce the nighttime power further or cease nighttime operations if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. IHM must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date the FCC Form 302 application was filed with the audiofilings team. Otherwise an e-mail must be submitted to confirm the date the station was able to resume licensed

operations per BZ-20100525AFJ, with negligible changes to all engineering parameters.

This authority expires on **February 25, 2023**.
