Dear Mr. Langham:

This is in reference to the request filed on June 14, 2022. IHM requests a final extension of the STA granted on December 21, 2021, to continue operating with parameters at variance and reduced power to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application.¹ In support of the request, IHM stated that it plans to complete all remaining work and then file the application with the audiofilings team within the next few months.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:


- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and IHM may continue to operate with DA parameters at variance from licensed values and reduced power (if needed) to maintain all monitor points within licensed limits. IHM must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310.

This authority expires on **December 23, 2022**.

¹ KBME(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 790 kHz with 5 kW day and night, using different patterns.
