Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authority**


iHM Licenses, LLC (“iHM”), licensee of WDAE(AM), St. Petersburg, Florida, by its counsel, hereby requests an extension of Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) for the station to operate at variance from its license to negate the effects of destructive Cuban interference. An STA, BESTA-20220302AAB, was granted on March 18, 2022, for a period expiring on September 17, 2022.

Under the STA, WDAE is permitted to operate with a nominal power of 11.2 kW day (ND)/11.0 kW night (DA); using an antenna input power of 11.2 kW day/11.6 kW night. Because the destructive Cuban interference continues to disrupt WDAE(AM)’s operations, iHM respectfully requests an extension of its STA.

The licensee has authorized undersigned counsel to certify on its behalf that the licensee is not subject to denial of Federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 862.
