Dear Mr. Pacheco:

This is in reference to the request filed on September 12, 2022. FD7B requests an extension of the STA granted on March 15, 2022, to continue operating with a reduced daytime power of 3 kW to allow time to replace or repair the 5 kW transmitter. In support of the request, FD7B stated that additional time will be needed to obtain parts to repair the transmitter.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and FD7B may continue to operate with a reduced daytime power of 3 kW with no change to the licensed nighttime 2.5 kW operation. FD7B must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310. After the 5 kW transmitter has been repaired or replaced, FD7B must submit a brief e-mail to my attention to note the date the station resumed licensed operations per BML-20060821AEE with negligible changes to all engineering parameters.

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¹ KPT(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 790 kHz with 5 kW day and 2.5 kW night using different patterns.

This authority expires on March 14, 2023.
