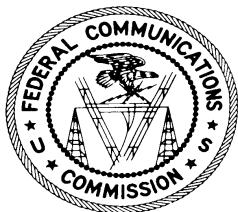

Sacred Heart Radio, Inc. is a non-stock, non-profit corporation chartered in Washington state with tax-exempt status granted by the Internal Revenue Service pursuant to 26 U.S.C. §501(c)(3). Sacred Heart Radio, Inc. hereby certifies that it will operate station KBKW(AM), Aberdeen, Washington, in accordance with Section 73.503 of the FCC's Rules.

Sacred Heart Radio, Inc. is licensee of non-commercial educational FM stations KBKO, Kodiak, Alaska, Facility ID #177368, and KYTR, Union Gap, Washington, Facility ID #175692. The Commission first found Sacred Heart Radio, Inc. to be qualified to own and operate non-commercial educational FM stations in the reserved portion of the FM band in File No. BAPED-20120502ABT, granted June 8, 2012. Sacred Heart Radio, Inc. is also licensee of non-commercial educational AM stations KBLE, Seattle, Washington, Facility ID #33667, KBUP, Olympia, Washington, Facility ID #34486, KLAY, Lakewood, Washington, Facility ID #11890, and KTTO, Spokane, Washington, Facility ID #38492.

Sacred Heart Radio, Inc.'s claim of exemption from the payment of application processing fees pursuant to Section 1.1116(c) of the FCC's Rules was honored when it applied: (1) to acquire the license of KBLE(AM), Seattle, Washington, File No. BAL-20001130AAU, granted January 11, 2001; (2) to acquire the license of KTTO(AM) (formerly KTRW), Spokane, Washington, File No. BAL-20050722ABE, granted September 7, 2005; and (3) to acquire the license of KBUP(AM) (formerly KGY), Olympia, Washington, File No. BAL-20140702AAA, granted September 16, 2014. Moreover, Sacred Heart Radio,

Inc. is listed as exempt from the payment of annual regulatory fees.

Educational Mission of SHR

Sacred Heart Radio, Inc. (SHR) is a State of Washington non-profit corporation which was formed to, *inter alia*, engage in educational activities. As noted above, it has been granted tax exempt status pursuant to 26 U.S.C §501(c)(3) by the Internal Revenue Service.

In practice, SHR's educational mission involves the following:

a. For providing regular educational programming designed to teach the Bible and the Catechism of the Roman Catholic Church in a manner which can be utilized by local Roman Catholic schools as well as by the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine educational programs administered by local Roman Catholic parish churches.

b. Working with Roman Catholic educational and contemplative institutions, including but not limited to Franciscan University of Steubenville at Steubenville, Ohio and Our Lady of the Angels Monastery at Irondale, Alabama, for the presentation of quality educational programming.

c. For providing programming which can be used to train laymen for an active and effectual role in Roman Catholic parish life, such as lector, catechism teacher, etc.

SHR has been implementing this program over KBLE(AM), Seattle, Washington since March, 2001, since September, 2005 over KTTO(AM), Spokane, Washington, since June, 2012 over KBKO(FM), Kodiak, Alaska, since June, 2014 over KYTR(FM), Union Gap, Washington, since October, 2014 over KBUP(AM) (formerly KGY), Olympia, Washington, and since January, 2019..

Programming In Furtherance of SHR's Educational Mission

Most of the programming to be aired by SHR over KBKW(AM) will come from the radio service of Eternal Word Television Network (EWTN). EWTN is headquartered on the former site of Our Lady of the Angels Monastery in Irondale, Alabama, which was founded and operated by the Roman Catholic

order of nuns known as Poor Clares of Perpetual Adoration. The founder of Our Lady of the Angels is Mother M. Angelica, P.C.P.A. The main purpose of EWTN has been described by Mother Angelica as "catechesis": that is, the teaching of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the Catechism of the Roman Catholic Church.

EWTN's programming is commercial-free, and there is no paid programming which is aired on EWTN. Such programming would be broadcast over KYTR(FM) in a commercial-free manner. Programming consists of the following basic types: (1) rebroadcasts of "Interactive" programs which involve a host or moderator and call-in questions from listeners; (2) recorded programs presented by eminent Roman Catholic professors and scholars dealing with various topics of the Gospels and Roman Catholic catechism (categories 1 and 2 occupy a majority of the broadcast day); (3) Roman Catholic Masses, the Holy Rosary and various recitations of various devotionals; and (4) news programs known by the title "Catholic World Today" and "The World Over".

The current Sacred Heart Radio programming schedule on KBLE(AM), which would be broadcast over **KBKW(AM)**, is appended hereto.

Thus, the programming to be presented on KBKW(AM) constitutes a comprehensive daily effort to educate the public, Catholics and non-Catholics, about the tenets and dogmas of the Roman Catholic faith, including the Bible and the systematic Catechism of the Roman Catholic Church. SHR will work with local Roman Catholic organizations in Aberdeen, Hoquiam and Grays Harbor County to assist their educational efforts with respect to teaching of the

Catholic religion. In short, **KBKW(AM)** will provide, a valuable educational resource which serves the public interest, convenience and necessity.
