Salem Communications Holding Corporation ("SCHC") is the licensee of KPXQ(AM), Glendale, AZ, facility ID 55912 and KXXT(AM), Tolleson, AZ, facility ID 54742. SCHC holds a construction permit, BP-20210528AAJ, to relocate the co-owned transmission facilities of KXXT to the licensed transmitter site of station KPXQ and diplex onto the KPXQ existing three tower array. SCHC is currently authorized to operate station KPXQ(AM) pursuant to special temporary authority ("STA"), BSTA-20220318AAB, with parameters at variance from license values and/or reduced power while the diplex facility is being constructed. Such construction has begun. As part of the construction, tower base insulators and guywire insulators need to be replaced to handle the additional power. The insulators have been received and a tower crew is being scheduled to install them. SCHC hereby requests an extension of the STA while work continues on the new facility.

The licensee has authorized undersigned counsel to certify on its behalf that the licensee is not subject to denial of Federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 862.
