Requests For Extension of
Special Temporary Authority
To Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Macias:

This letter concerns the requests, filed on September 25, 2008, on behalf of Aztec Communications of Alabama, Inc. ("Aztec"), for extension of Special Temporary Authority ("STA") to permit AM Stations WCOC and WGTA to remain silent.


Commission records reflect that AM Stations WCOC and WGTA went silent on December 1, 2007, for financial reasons. STAs to remain silent were granted on December 5, 2007, and expired on June 2, 2008. Aztec's request for an extension of its STA states that the licensee continues to experience financial difficulties. Aztec further states that negotiations are currently in progress for the sale of the stations. Aztec's requests include the appropriate certifications regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

Aztec's requests will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit AM Stations WCOC and WGTA to remain silent not to exceed December 1, 2008. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast licenses for WCOC(AM) and WGTA(AM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m. on**

December 2, 2008.¹ *See* Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Section 312(g).

The stations' silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the stations' towers shall be maintained. *See* 47 C.F.R. Sections 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
